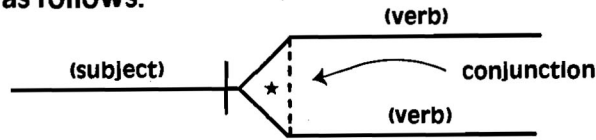
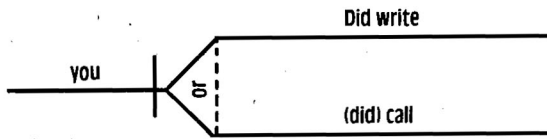


The N-V sentence may consist of a simple subject and its compound verb. It is diagrammed as follows:

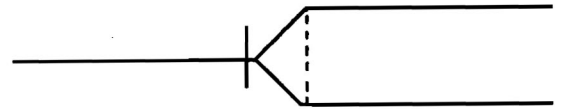
