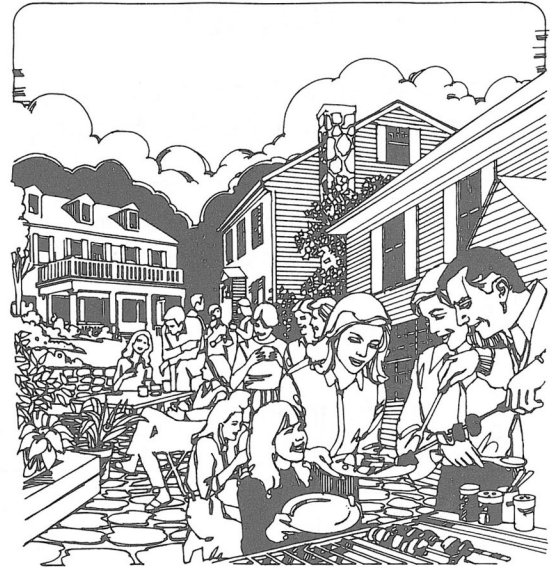


Singular and Plural
